Re: PGC COVID-19 Policy as of April 1, 2022

Aloha all,

The State of Hawai'i has lifted the indoor mask mandate as of March 26, 2022. In response to updated guidance and low COVID-19 case rates, the wearing of masks will now be optional at Pacific Gateway Center and all of its locations. Nevertheless, we ask for your kokua in continuing to practice safety precautions:

1. Temperature checks will still be required for entry.
2. Masks are optional in all places except common areas at our facilities.
3. Continue with proper hand hygiene.
4. Social distancing as needed. Avoid congregating.

If you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, chills, soreness, loss of taste or smell) or any other symptoms of illness, please do not come to or enter our facilities and seek medical attention immediately. You may return when your symptoms have subsided.

Pacific Gateway Center reserves the right to ask for a vaccine card, as needed. If you test positive for COVID-19, please advise one of our staff immediately so we can take action to secure the health and safety of others who work or do business at PGC.
